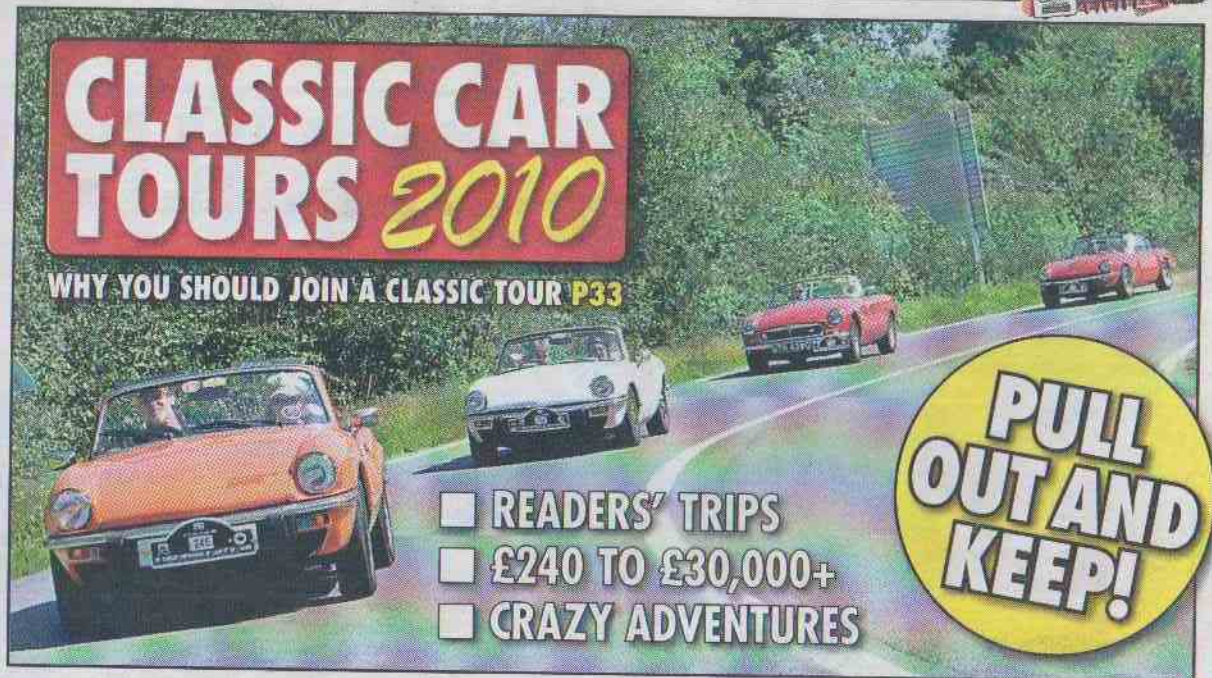

There's no direct service to Italy or Spain from either Calais or Paris, so you'd have to start in Dusseldorf in Germany or s'Hertogenbosch in Holland, and it'll cost you about £650 each way from there to northern Italy. So you need an alternative. Fly to Sicily and drive a hired 500 on roads that seem made for it, with fabulous hill-top villages, beautiful coastlines and jagged mountains. The 500 Vintage Tour company also offers 'follow my leader' tours on fascinating routes like 'In the steps of The Godfather.'
